STORYTIME ART → Story time art begins with the reading of a picture book story by award-winning authors and illustrators. Then, students will do art projects based on the story and the illustrations. Projects are open-ended and are designed so that many skill levels can participate. Different media and methods will be explained to the children throughout the course. For children 3-6 years, **1 hour class**.

TODDLER ART :: Hands-on fun for toddlers 18 months to 3 years, with an adult companion. Children will practice drawing, painting, ripping and gluing skills, and then prepare a snack. **45-minute class**

AFTER SCHOOL ART → This after school art program is for children ages 6 - 9. We will focus on 2-D art, including drawing and painting, collage, printmaking, and mixed media projects. In some classes, we will study famous artists, learning to recognize their styles while attempting to use the same mediums. In others, we will focus on developing individual style and promoting competence in the various mediums. Special attention will be given to improving drawing and rendering skills. Projects are open-ended and are designed so that many skill levels can participate without being either bored or overwhelmed by the level of difficulty. Different mediums and methods will be explained to the children throughout the course. All materials will be provided.

Depending on the interests and abilities of the students, some 3-D projects may be added to the curriculum.

PORTFOLIO CLASS → This class is for students in 5th grade and above, who need an art portfolio in order to apply to magnet schools or college. This rigorous class will provide students with 6 - 8 finished works. We will focus on portraiture, landscape, and still life, in various mediums.
